

**RESOLUTION
DESIGNATING OFFICIALS TO CALCULATE DISTRICT
AD VALOREM TAX RATES AND PREPARE RELATED
TRUTH IN TAXATION DOCUMENTS**

WHEREAS, the **HARDIN COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT No. 2** (the "**District**") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas operating under chapter 775 of the Texas Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, the District is required to adopt its ad valorem tax rate under the provisions of chapter 26 of the Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Code requires the District to designate an official to prepare the District's tax rate calculations as part of the Truth In Taxation process; and

WHEREAS, the District finds that the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector and his/her staff are tax professionals who are qualified to prepare the tax calculations upon receipt of the material from the Hardin County Appraisal District and present the tax rate calculations required by law,

NOW THEREFORE, the District adopts the following resolution:

1. The District designates the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector (and his/her staff) as the official who will prepare the District's tax rate calculations and related Truth In Taxation material for tax year 2026 and subsequent years until such time as the District changes the designation.
2. The District asks the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector (and his/her staff) to take whatever actions are necessary to secure the certified appraisal information from the Hardin County Appraisal District and any other entities necessary to complete the calculations.
3. The District asks the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector (and his/her staff) to provide the tax rate calculations and related Truth In Taxation material to the District through District staff in a timely manner to allow for the adoption of the annual ad valorem tax rate in compliance with the schedule required by the Tax Code.
4. The District instructs its staff and contractors to coordinate with the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector (and his/her staff) in any way necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution – the timely presentation of the required tax rate calculations to the District Board of Commissioners for action to set the District ad valorem tax rate.

NOW THEREFORE, the District approves this Resolution designating the Hardin County Tax Assessor-Collector to calculate the District tax rates, effective the 17th day of June 2026.
